Dear Pastors, Friends, and Partners of Selah International,

"Remember (be mindful of) them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end (results) of their conversation (way of life)." (Hebrews 13:7)

In this passage, the author of Hebrews strongly urges us to be mindful of those who are faithfully feeding us from God's Word and encourages us to imitate their faith. **Take note of the results of the faithfulness of your pastor and share those with him!** The month of October is Pastor Appreciation month, and this is what our ministry is all about. Our heart is to strengthen the hearts of men and women in ministry and provide a safe place for healing when they find themselves in difficult and perplexing challenges. <u>No one can encourage a pastor like one of his own flock.</u> I encourage you to intentionally support your pastor and pastor's wife. **Come beside them as allies in the spiritual battle for the souls of men**. Here are a couple of specific areas you can target as you fervently pray for them:

- Pray that your pastor will see their world from God's perspective. "The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good." (Proverbs 15:3)
- Pray that your pastor will be consistent in the spiritual disciplines and care for his own soul. "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life." (Proverbs 4:23)
- Pray that your pastor will depend on God's sustaining grace through personal and ministerial challenges. "Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." (Philippians 4:11–13)

Over the past few months, we have had the privilege of hosting several local pastors and wives. It is a blessing to get to know ministry leaders that are serving the Lord in the greater Columbia area. It is our desire to encourage and to partner with them for the sake of the gospel. We were also able to host four other ministry families for personal counseling intensives during the month of August. It was a joy to see the Word of God transform these dear servants



as they worked through struggles with trauma, chronic illness, and even sinful choices.
